

## 2019 Youth Camp Information

**REGISTRATION:** ALL REGISTRATIONS MUST BE DONE ONLINE BY A CHURCH LEADER. Carefully read the camp fees and dates on the registration form. A parent or guardian MUST SIGN a camper application for EACH STUDENT, regardless of the camper's age. That application MUST be brought to camp by the church leader.

### **CAMP SCHEDULE**

**FULL WEEK :** Registration begins Monday at 1pm.  
Camp ends Friday at 10:30 am.

**SHORTER WEEK:** Registration begins at 6:00 pm on Wednesday and ends Saturday @ 10:30 am.

**GRADE LEVEL DIVISIONS:** We believe that students have a more enjoyable and appropriate experience at camp with others their age. Housing is done according to gender, church, and grade level. Students enrolled in the Fall of 2018 in grades 6-8 will be placed together - same for grades 9-12.

**Guidelines & Policies:** These are given as guidelines for every camper to follow. This code of conduct has been established for your protection and the benefit of every person present. You have agreed to abide by this code during the camp(s) by signing the registration form.

1. Each camper must agree to abide by the dress code at all times.
2. The daily schedule must be observed by everyone. Attendance at all camp activities is required of all campers unless granted permission by the Youth Camp Director.
3. No one is allowed to leave the campgrounds without specific permission from the Camp Director.
4. The possession or use of tobacco, drugs, or alcohol is forbidden and will result in dismissal.
5. No cell phones, MP3 players, firearms, knives, fireworks, communication devices, or articles of clothing displaying questionable content are allowed.
6. We reserve the right to inspect contents of all personal belongings. The holding and /or disposal of improper contents is the right of the camp.
7. No camper will be allowed in ANY other dorm room than the one to which they are assigned.
8. The Points, residential areas, and lake areas are off limits unless involved in an approved activity.
9. Expression of affection between couples is limited to holding of hands.
10. Each camper will perform his/her duties as part of the privilege of being at camp. Rooms / adjacent grounds must be kept clean daily.
11. You are urged and expected to observe habits of personal cleanliness, courtesy, and Christian conduct. Profanity is not allowed.

**CAMP DRESS CODE:** Clothing must be modest and appropriate. Modest swimwear is permitted (one-piece suits preferred or suits designed for high activity). Shorts, shirts, or dresses/skirts that are modest in length are required. Shorts are allowed for all activities including the evening service. Tattoos and body piercings must be unobtrusive and noncontroversial in content. ALL STAFF must be an example in attitude and action by complying with the dress code and rules as well.

The lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect for property, or an unwholesome attitude on the part of any camper will result in expulsion from camp. Parents are asked to help in explaining these rules to their student and in encouraging their compliance while at camp. Arrangements and expense of transporting expelled campers home from camp is the responsibility of the parents. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR EXPELLED STUDENTS.**

**CAMP PROPERTY DAMAGE:** Charges for items broken/damaged or stolen during camp will be billed to the parties/individuals involved.

**WHAT TO BRING:** Sleeping bag or bedding for a twin size bed, appropriate clothing for both daytime activities and night services, personal hygiene items, Bible, spending money for snacks and camp store. Campers and staff are responsible for their own personal belongings. SMYM is not responsible for lost/stolen items.

**CAMP LOCATION:** On the North shore of Lake of the Ozarks in Rocky Mt., MO; 10 miles South of Eldon, MO at the end of Hwy Y.
